- 1. Introductions Greg and Erik
- 2. Vote in Erik as treasure TC nominates, CM seconded, all in favor, none opposed.
  - a. Erik is 2016 treasurer and will work with Rob P. (former treasurer) to get up to speed.
- 3. Trail Director Updates:
  - a. Daniels Road SF updates (OD and AP):
    - i. Parking lot complete, 20 plus cars, wider road.
    - ii. Gates closed until spring at least (pending settlement on easement with Skidmore)
    - iii. Hopefully a kiosk by the state.
    - iv. New trail discussion -
      - 1. Trail directors will map with GPS so we can discuss with Rick McDermott.
    - v. Rick made it clear in recent correspondence that there can be no new trail construction until UMP, after which proposed trails must go thru the DEC's approval process.
      - 1. AND ANY UNAPPROVED TRAIL BUILDING WILL RESULT IN SMBA LOSING OUR STEWARDSHIP AGREEMENT
  - b. Pittstown SF CC
    - i. Will start grooming for fat biking when enough snow. DEC on board with this.
    - ii. Logging supposed to start last fall, now next spring (2016).
  - c. Poestenkill Community Forest IB/JA
    - i. Got tools from Rogue Hoe. More on list to purchase in prep for spring/ trail building.
    - ii. Have a place to store the tools near property.
    - iii. RPA plans to flag some trails so winter trail users can use CF when enough snow.
    - iv. Trail markers for RPA CF a possible donation opportunity for local business. SMBA could facilitate.
    - v. CF Skills park RPA applied for grant to fund infrastructure for pump track.

- 1. CC question for board: Does SMBA want to become involved with pump track?
  - a. Board discussion: Liability a big concern, need to be cautious with what and how we present ideas/plans to RPA for pump track. CC will present these concerns with RPA at next RPA trail committee meeting. General consensus is to try to find a way to help.
- d. Thacher SP CM
  - Skills park in master plan for Thacher. First bid went out but was not successful. Second bid package was successful. Hopefully moving dirt in the spring.
- 4. Update on MTB Festival @ Grafton in June CC and subcommittee
  - a. Last two years Pitts-Grafton Epic started at PSF. SF limitations fees, collections, donations, etc. These challenges are avoided at State Parks so a subcommittee is looking at starting event in GSP this year so that it can be expanded.
  - b. Tentative date is June 11. SP ok with that.
  - c. Demos possible
    - TC and IA will reach out soon to their brand contacts for demos.
  - d. Tomhannock already committed to helping.
  - e. Subcommittee will meet again soon and set date.
  - f. Next subcommittee meeting will decide how to do fundraiser.
  - g. Nat'l Mountain Bike Day and IMBA's TAKMTBD is also June 11 this year.
  - h. There will be a waiver for everyone to sign including members
  - i. SMBA members will probably have discount.
  - j. Pre registration option being considered.

    - i. Specialized Grant page

    - iii. Trail hub possible option for website JH will look into
  - b. Send JH winter photos on SMBA trails if you have any.
- 6. ADK Park Agency State Land Master Plan Amendments CM etc.
  - a. as amendment to the existing management plan old utility roads in primitive areas can be designated as either primitive recreational trails (type 3b, meaning can go in with equipment for repairs/maintenance) or bicycle trails (type 3a, meaning not maintained using motor vehicles). The decision will not affect designation of these roads, just affects maintenance. If harder to maintain, it will get maintained less. CM leaning toward 3b. Board discussion and general agreement.
  - b. Have until Jan 29 to submit.
  - c. SMBA will submit a comment. CM will draft and send around to board for review.

- d. Anyone with comments/opinions or wants to write SMBA's position, contact CM
- 7. Grafton FatBike Ride CM
  - a. Held during Grafton Winterfest this Jan 23 @ 10am
  - b. SMBA will have table/booth, as manageable, based on participation contact CC to assist
- 8. ADK Sport and Fitness Expo
  - a. Board agrees to do it again. Will set up coverage schedule when confirmed.
  - b. March 5-6. set up March 3 pm.
  - c. CM will confirm with ADK
- 9. Update on maps, stickers for 2016 TC
  - a. TC wants to do double sided with DRSF and PSF again but fit in advertisers
  - b. IA/TC will form subgroup to work on new large format map
  - c. Need maps finished and printed and in hand by ADK Expo so if revisions are not completed in next month or so will need to run with old map again.

  - b. Same pricing? discussion but no decision
  - c. Discussion about using Paypal vs BikeReg or SMBA eating fees.
